Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020).
- 1.2. Each participating boat shall comply with respective Class Rules

2. Advertising

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. Regatta is open to the following classes: X-Boat, Optimist, Melges 14 and O'Pen Bic. Minimum of 5 boats must register by 6/28/2019 to form a class.
- 3.2. Competitors shall meet age requirements for ILYA X-Boat and Optimist Dinghy classes
- 3.3. Melges 14 competitors can choose Red Blue or Yellow sail types at the time of registration. No changes of sail will be permitted after registration. For charter boats contact <u>Melges Boat Works</u>
- 3.4. Junior competitors' parents or guardians will be required to sign a waiver of liability at check-in.
- 3.5. All competitors shall wear, while on the water, a properly fastened U.S. Coast Guard approved, Inherently Buoyant Type III PFDs

4. Registration and Fees

- 4.1. All entry fees shall be paid during online registration at www.glss.org
- 4.2. Entry fees: X-Boat \$100, Optimist \$65, Melges14 and O'Pen Bic: \$45 If paid by 6/28/2019
- 4.3. A late fee of \$20 per sailor shall be paid for registrations completed from 6/29/2019 through 7/7/2019
- 4.4. An additional \$50 late fee per sailor shall be paid after 7/7/2019
- 4.5. Lunches and Dinner packages can be purchased during registration. Additional Dinner Tickets and Regatta T-shirts can be purchased online or during the event.

4.6. Entry Fees are NONREFUNDABLE and may not be transferred to another event
