



OKTOBERFEST SINGLEHANDED REGATTA 10/15-16, 2022 Notice of Race



1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2021-2024).
- 1.2. Each participating boat shall comply with respective Class Rules

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. Regatta is open to Laser and Optimist Class. Melges 14 class will be open if 5 boats register.
- 3.2. Competitors shall choose Laser 4.7, Radial or Standard rig at the time of registration.
- 3.3. Junior competitors' parents or guardians will be required to sign a waiver of liability at check-in.
- 3.4. All competitors shall wear, while on the water, a properly fastened U.S. Coast Guard approved, Inherently Buoyant Type III PFDs

4. Registration and Fees

- 4.1. All entry fees shall be paid during online registration at www.glss.org
- 4.2. Entry fees: \$65,
- 4.3. No Lunches will be included
- 4.4. Entry Fees are NONREFUNDABLE and may not be transferred to another event
- 4.5. Registration will close Thursday, October 13, 2022, at midnight.
